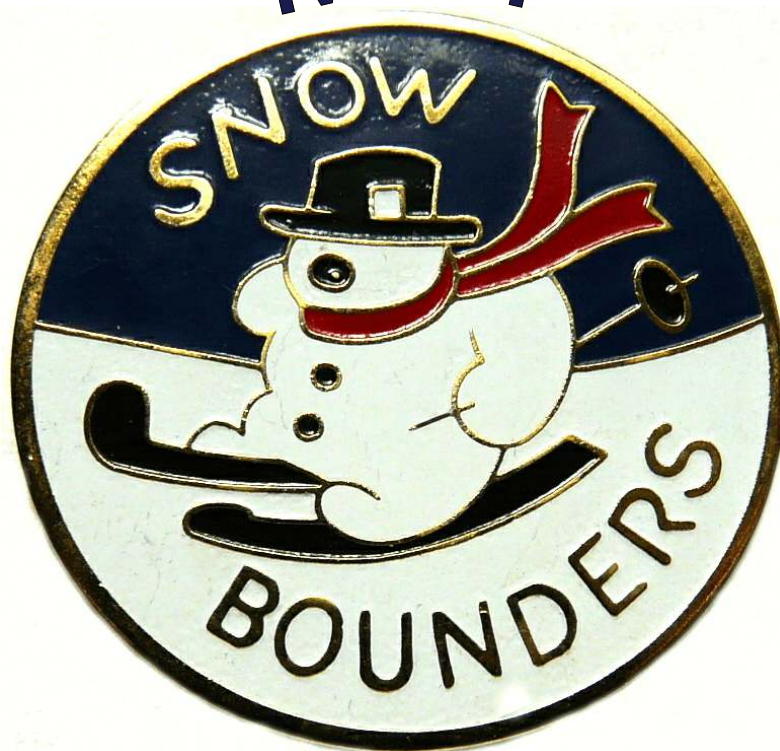

FROM MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN MIKE REED: Our membership stands at 54 members. Renewal time for year 2022/23 is coming soon.

FROM THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD BILL HOUCK: A report on the "State of the Club" in 2022.
Our by-laws state that "The objective of the club shall be to encourage and develop the skiing interest and activities of it's members. Among the means to this end shall be the holding of meetings and the planning of the club trips and social events." In order to accommodate these objectives, the club elects or appoints 17 members to positions including officers, board members and event coordinators. Some members serve two positions. Due possibly to the pandemic, aging, and/or health problems, activities have been limited and poorly attended. We had 9 skiers on the January Mammoth trip, no club sponsored February trip, and the March trip was cancelled due to lack of skiers. There were 5 members on the hike in March, 7 members at the March dine-out and 10 members at the April dine-out. One solution to this "top heavy" situation is to have more activities. We need interested members to volunteer to create new or restore old activities. For example, picnics were well attended and seemed to be enjoyed by all who attended. But, some one has to pick a date, pick a time, pick a site, arrange for food, write the notice to be posted in the newsletter, petition the board for money if the club will subsidize the event and if so, decide what food, recruit some one to pick it up and deliver it on time. So you see the problem, the members who have been doing these things are getting old and tired and need to be replaced by some new blood. Any volunteers?
