Shilo Inn has ample covered parking. It is more convenient to the main supermarket and good dining establishments.

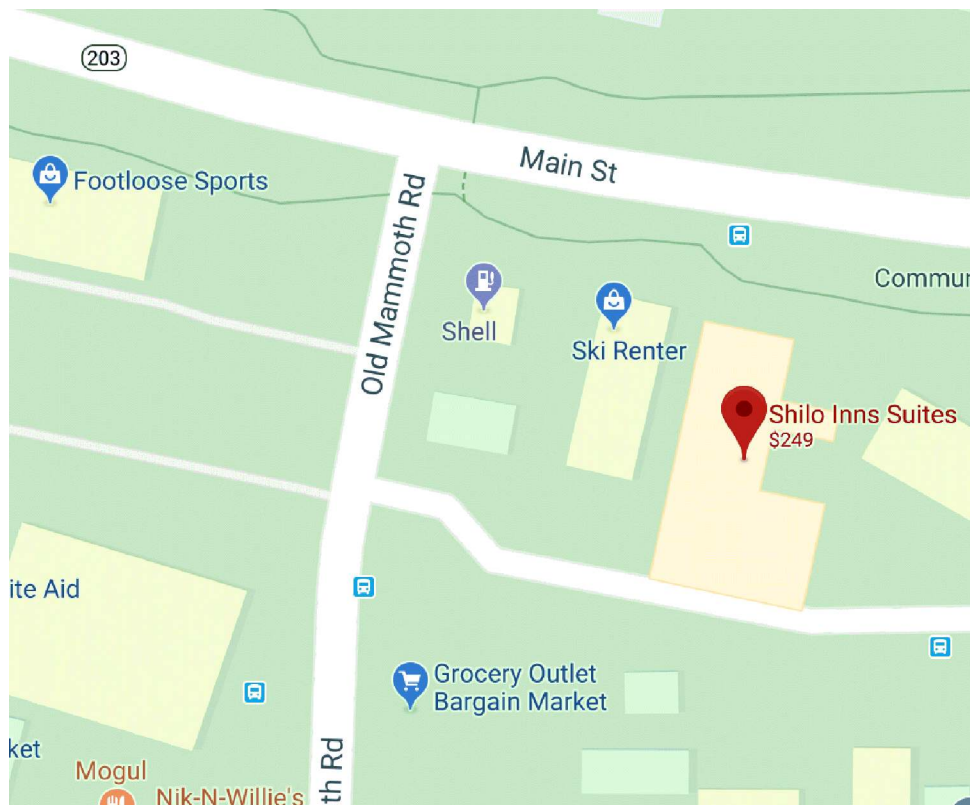
Shuttle services to Canyon Lodge and to the Main Lodge are right around the corner on Old Mammoth Road.

SUN VALLEY SITE VISIT REPORT - January 30-Feb. 6 2021

Lodge Choices:

1. Limelight Lodge – Ketchum 50 rooms. Hotel king beds, Hotel 2 queen beds. [REDACTED] (deposit of [REDACTED] to hold rooms).!!!!!!
2. Sun Valley Inn Hotel- 40rms/80pillows (King) 1,220.00 Hotel 2 Queen Beds 30rms/60 pillows 1,220.00 (\$910.00 Single Supplement)
3. Sun Valley Lodge Apartments – Condos 2 Bedrooms(K&Twins) 12 units 48 pillows [REDACTED], 3 Bedroom (K,Q,T) 20 Units 120 pillows [REDACTED] (\$900 Single Supplement) No Split Kings
4. Sun Valley Lodge Hotel King Beds 5 Units(10 Pillows) [REDACTED] Queen Beds 30 units/60 pillows [REDACTED] (\$1,140 Single Supplement)

Orange Council – Air Transportation will be out of Orange County into either Boise and bussed into Sun Valley(2.5) hr drive. Or Fly Directly into Sun Valley. The bus trip cost is Approximately 105.00.
