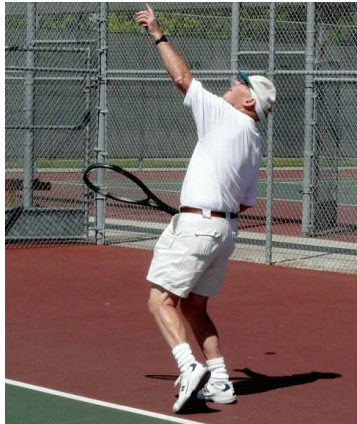
2017 SKI TRIPS
